HAF IN WOODLEY

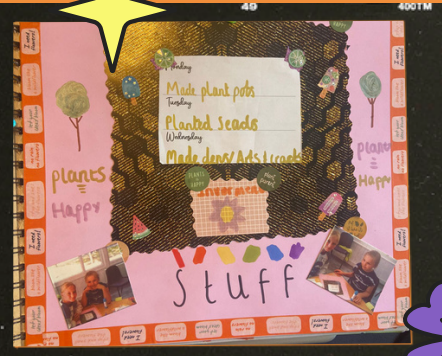
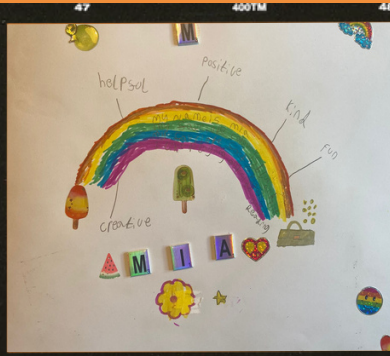
We have had a busy summer in Woodley!

- ~We had a Silent Disco for our final party!

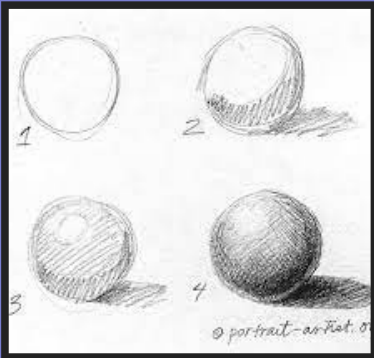

★ HOW TO: SHADE



1. Draw a faint outline.
2. Start with a light scribble.
3. Press harder at one end, gradually pressing lighter to create different light/dark shades.
4. Use your finger to make a blended shade, or hard lines to create texture.

TIP: KEEP WORKING OVER THE SHAPE TO MAKE IT SMOOTH AND LESS PATCHY!
